Objectives of the study: The study aims to know the extent to which the courses of the current Islamic culture of education policy in Saudi Arabia, it also aims, through analyzing the vocabulary of the courses of Islamic culture, to find a realistic judgment on these courses that they represent and follow the correct and upright approach according to the policy of education, which was based on the Quran and the Sunnah.

The main results of the study: the most important results of the study:

- 1- The educational policy in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia has been set by university education courses in general and Islamic culture in particular by including them in these courses and focusing on them in all public and private objectives.
- 2- The analysis of the courses of Islamic culture showed that the elements of educational policy were found in varying percentages in the sample of the study and it is significant that all courses of Islamic culture in the universities paying great importance to them.
- 3- By answering the questions of the study, the researcher developed a proposed concept for the development of Islamic culture courses in the light of the educational policy document in Saudi Arabia.

The main recommendations of the study: Based on the above, the researcher recommended several recommendations, the most important of which are:
